The peace talks arranged by the United Nations seeking to end the war in Sudan continue. There is still no representative from the Sudan Army. With one side of the conflicting groups missing there is little hope for any real progress from the talks. In

the last few days the United States called for a ceasefire, but there seems to be no real desire to take action to make meaningful change on the ground. Please keep praying for those who are facing the hardships of famine and homelessness and fear for their lives.

Fantasy Competitions Underway


