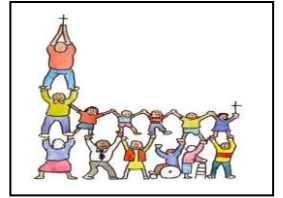

neighbours!

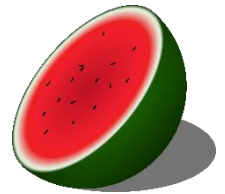

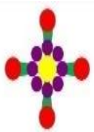
In your prayers this week please remember ...
