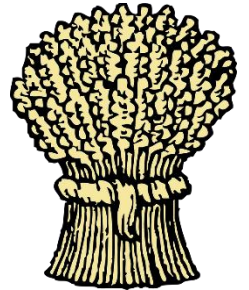
Donations for tea/coffee
