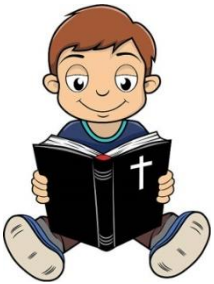
Unfortunately the service due to take place on 8th June at the Cathedral has been postponed. Confirmation of the rescheduled date will be announced as soon as it is available.
